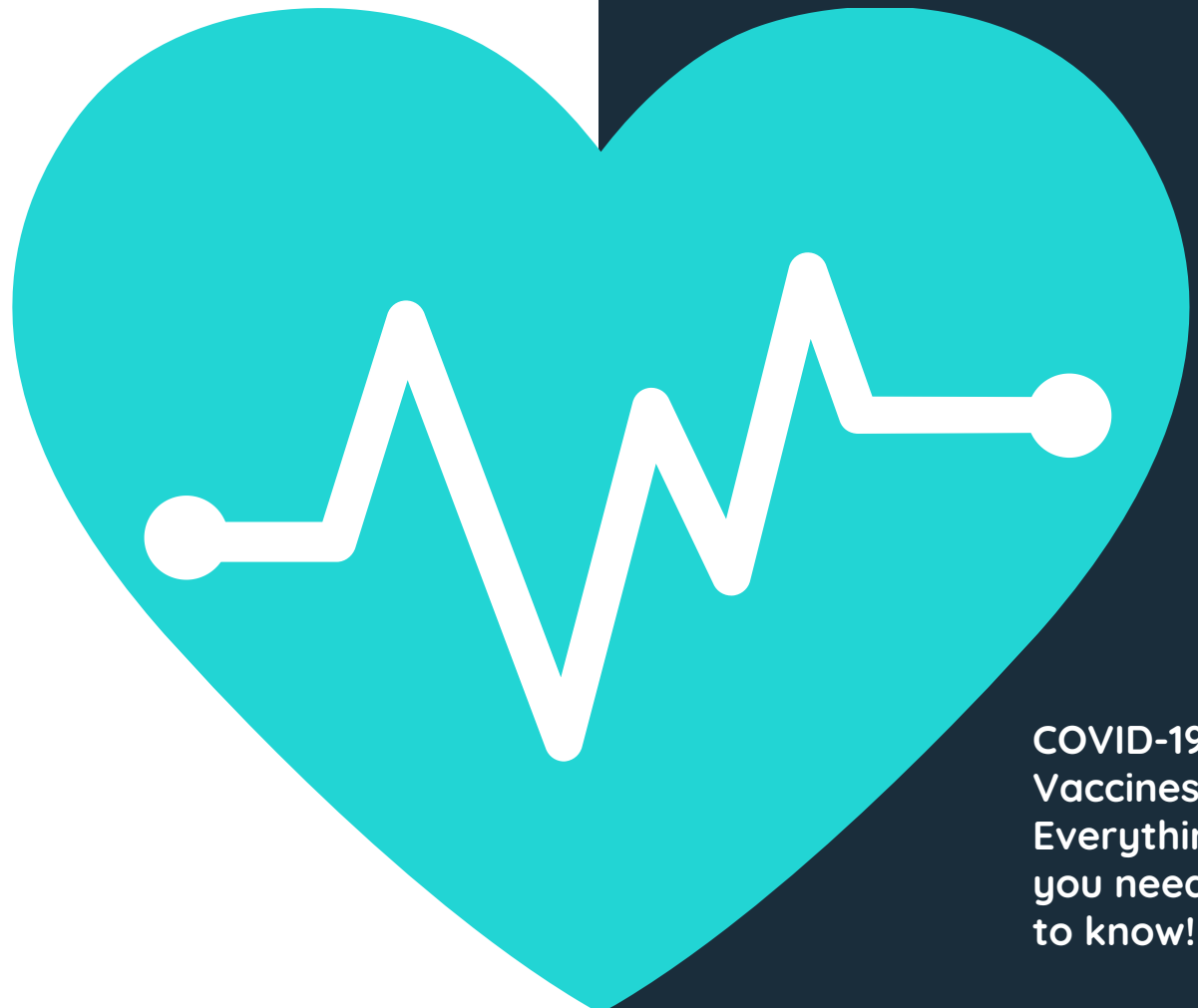

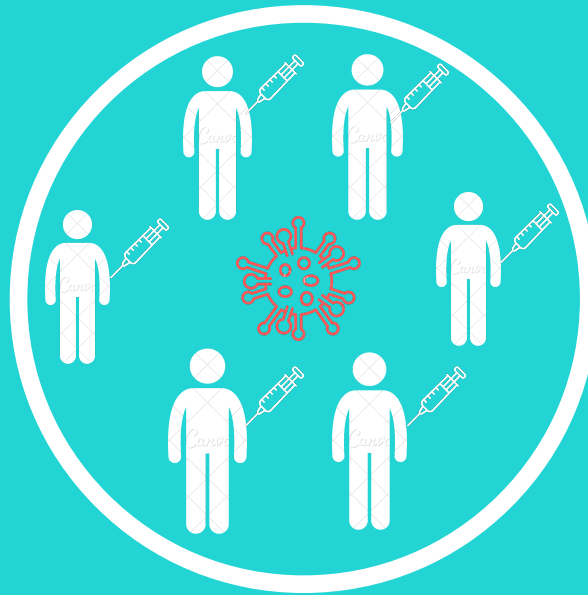
DEBUNKING MYTHS

1. This vaccine will not cause COVID-19 infections!
2. This vaccine does NOT contain a virus or part of the COVID-19 virus
3. The mRNA vaccines do NOT contain: pork products, egg, latex, preservatives, blood products, mercury, OR microchips

VACCINE INFORMATION

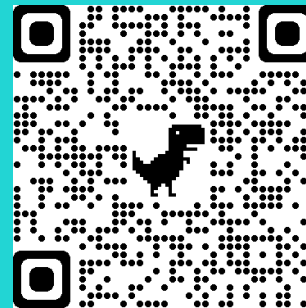
1. There are 3 brands of vaccine: Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson/Janssen (J&J)
2. There is NO COST for uninsured people
3. The J&J vaccine requires only 1 dose
4. The Pfizer and Moderna vaccines each require 2 doses
5. Protection is not immediate after you have received all of the required doses -- you will only be fully vaccinated and protected 1-2 weeks after that!
6. COVID-19 Vaccines are now available to EVERYONE 12 years old and older

HOW DOES THIS VACCINE WORK?

01

This vaccine will help your body create harmless antibodies which will train your immune system to identify and eliminate SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. Antibodies will prevent you from future infections and give you immunity without having to be sick first!

02

The more people vaccinated, the less places the virus has to go, helping us end the pandemic! This is called herd immunity.

Once you are vaccinated, it is still important to try to avoid crowds, stay 6 feet away from others, wear a mask, and wash hands often.
